Craven Mountaineering Club Committee Meeting 228- 15 May 2023. 19.30 – Held on Zoom MINUTES

10 participants: Steve Boy, Steve Webb, Stephen Gorman, Steve Prior, Ian Daws, Andy Barton, James Crawshaw, Dick Winslow, Michael Faulkner, Jon Lury. Apologies from David Canning, Dave Collier.

<u>Purpose of Meeting: To finish discussions about the future CMC objectives and how to achieve them.</u>

Agenda: Steve Boy's email dated 25 April 2023.

1. Committee Members - Number of, and roles:

After lengthy discussion at recent meetings, the consensus of those present was that the number of key committee roles probably needs to stay at 6*. We currently have 12 Cttee members. The extra committee members will help with ad-hoc tasks and make up numbers when the key role-holders cant make it to meetings.

*this assumes that the Cttee will not be responsible for coordinating all the meets. The cttee will suggest a "skeleton" number of meets and that members will propose many more meets on WhatsApp.

2. James Crawshaw to take over as Chairperson:

JC agreed to take over as long as all other committee members remained to support him. All present agreed. Steve Boy agreed to remain on the committee to help with ad hoc tasks.

3. Number of Club Members:

The consensus of those present was that the critical thing is to have as many club members as possible so that the number of active members attending meets is increased. We think that only ~25-30% of members are actually active attending meets (12-15 individuals overall, and only 3-8 on any meet), which agrees with our experience of other clubs. Therefore we need to increase the number of members and we are doing this via the new improved communication and advertising (FB, Instagram, revitalising the website).

AndyB reported that we currently have 12 prospective members, so there is increasing interest in the club.

4. Reasons for low attendance at meets:

a. Sometimes people cant do Tuesdays: but the consensus of those present was to stick with Tuesdays so that members get the habit of a regular day (and in AndyB's survey last year members voted to stick with Tuesday). And the day can be rearranged at short notice via WhatsApp.

- b. The problem with Tuesday evenings is sometimes also that people may not feel confident to climb as hard as regular attendees so we need to be flexible on grades and encourage members who cant get on the rock very often.
- c. All present agreed that sometimes it is easier to arrange to climb just with one other close friend, and we often do not share it with the club for various reasons. All present agreed to try harder to share dates and set clear expectations. E.g. "cant accommodate a single person, but another pair is fine".
- d. Motivation of members: All present agreed that AB's buddy calls are the best idea. AB has shared out names, others have not made many calls yet - but all present agreed to increase their effort on this.
